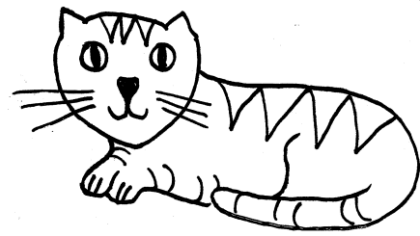

2. What was the secret that Kirandip discovered?

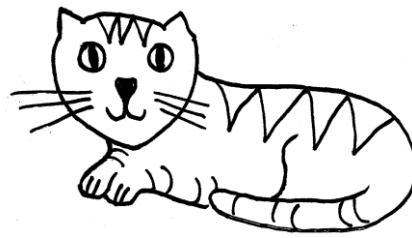
3. On page 17, find the part where Mrs Weston says 'you don't know the half'. What did she mean?
