

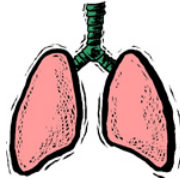
Preparing the Mummy

After the person had died their body was washed in water from the Nile. The liver, lungs, stomach and intestines were taken out and dried. The organs were then placed in canopic jars. Each jar has a different top.

Match the organs to the correct jar.



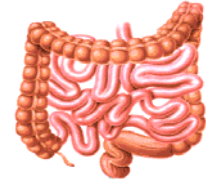
Liver
