6. There are 25 bean bags. Kim takes 12 and Mark takes 6. How many bean bags are left?
7. 5 people have 4 cakes each. How many cakes do they have altogether?
8. Paul buys 3 apples at 10p each. How much change would he get from 50p?
9. There are 15 apples, 12 bananas and 10 pears in a box of fruit. How many pieces of fruit are there altogether?
10. I think of a number, then halve it. The answer is nine. What was my number?
