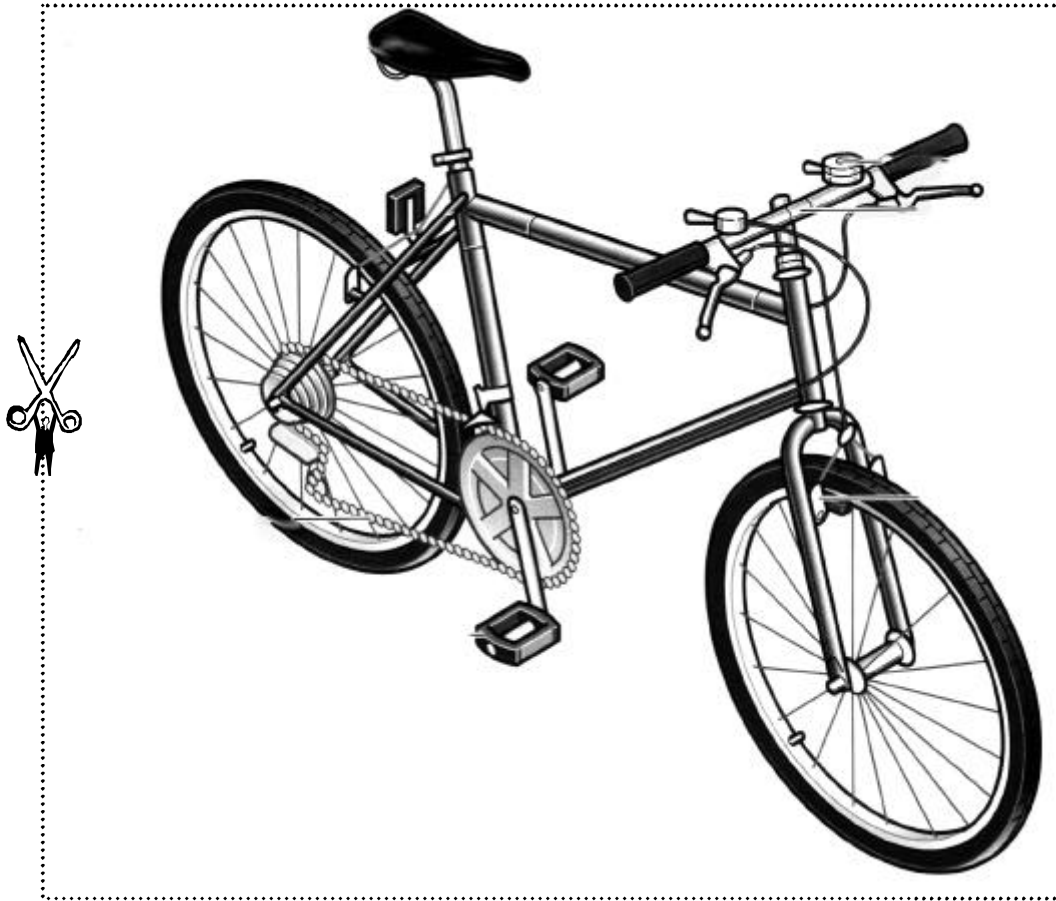


Non Fiction – labelling a picture.

Use these words:

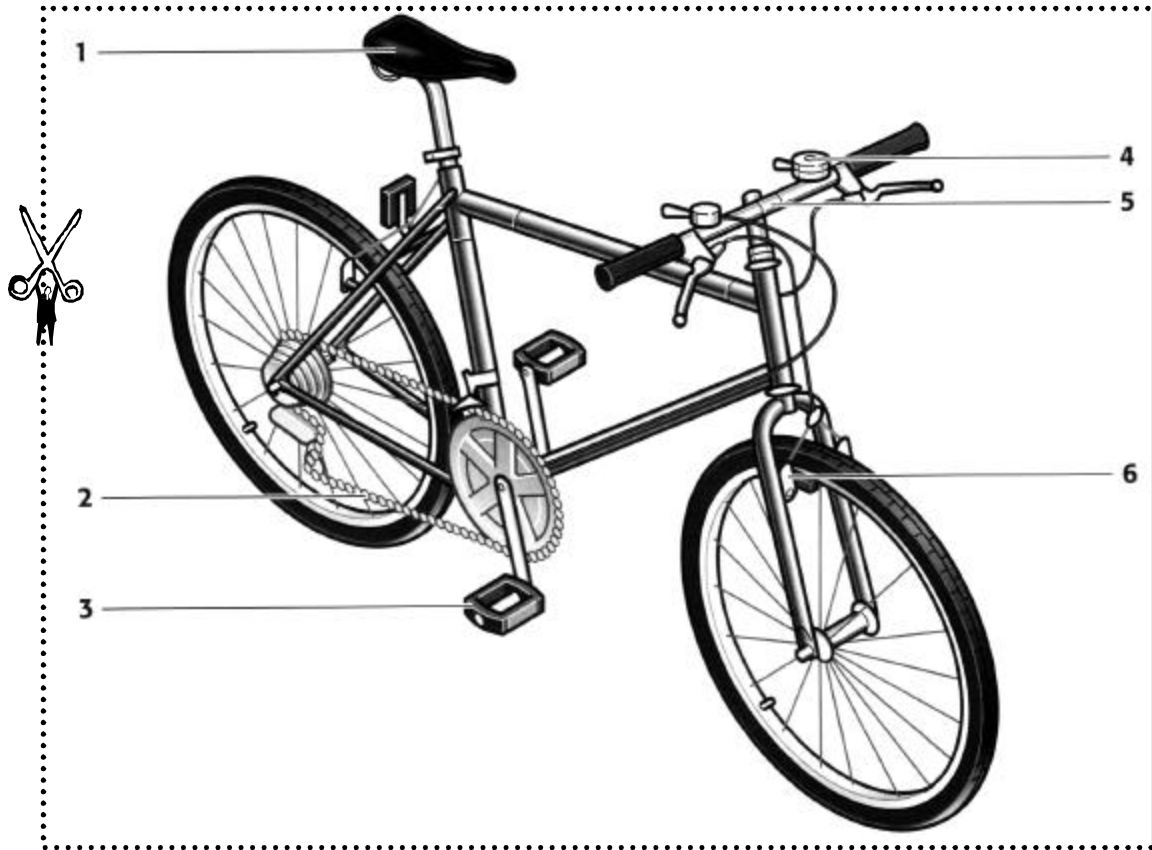
saddle brakes handlebar bell chain pedal
