

Purpose: To retell events.

**Structure:** Opening - setting the scene, eg *I went to the shop...* 

Events - recount of the events as they occurred, eg I saw a

vase...

Ending - a closing statement, eg When I got back, I told my

mum.

Features: Past tense

Chronological order, using connectives that signal time, eg

then, next, after, meanwhile, etc.

First or third person

## Writer's Knowledge:

Details are vital to bring incidents alive.

- Use specific names of people, places, objects, etc.
- Pick out incidents that will amuse, interest or that in someway are significant.
- You can write as if you were telling the story of what happened.
- Plan by thinking, noting or drawing when? who? where? what? and why? Use a flow chart to plan the sequence.
- End by commenting on events.
