Compose World Activity

Aims of the lesson:

- To be able to compose your own beginnings, middles and ends using the 'edit phrase' facility on Compose World.
- To be able to recognise beginnings, middles and ends.

Instructions for creating your own tune file on Compose World

Follow the instructions carefully and exactly and it will be easy to create your own tune files.

To open Compose World:

- 1. Log on.
- 2. Open 'Acorn Applications'
- 3. Open 'Music'
- 4. Double click on 'Compose World' to open it.
- 5. Double click on 'Compose 2'.

To create your tune file:

- 1. Put your pointer over the 'Phrases' window. (normally the one on the left)
- 2. Press the middle button and click once on 'New' with the left button.

This will create a new box for your tune file.

- 3. Put your pointer over the new window and click the middle button again.
- 4. Click once on 'edit phrase' with the left button.
- 5. Point the arrow over the note you want to write and how long you want it to be then press the left button once.
- 6. Press the play button, (>) listen to your tune and improve it if you think you need to.

 Compose at least one beginning, middle and end.

If you finish:

Repeat step 3 and click on 'edit picture'

Use the tools in the picture window to accompany your tune.

They work in the same way that 'Draw' does.
