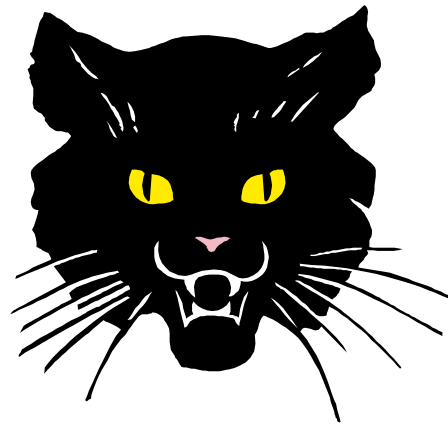


Using metaphors and similes
