2. Find synonyms for these words that describe Colin. Write both the question and the answer in your book.

b) "He had a <i>sad</i> face."	"He had a	face."
c) "He looked <i>ill</i> ."	"He looked	

4. Write two sentences describing the person next to you. Use lots of really good adjectives.

5. Write out the same two sentences again but this time, change the adjectives using synonyms. Use a thesaurus if you're stuck.

For example, "James is *big*. He has *tiny* feet."
