

## Comparatives

An **adjective** is a describing word.

When we **compare two nouns** we use a **comparative adjective**.

An example of this is the use of the endings: -er -est.

If you look at these sentences, we are using comparative adjectives to describe size.

A pony is **small**.

A cat is **smaller**.

A mouse is **smallest**.
