VERB: To be (Present tense)

I am

You_{ONE} are

He/she/it is

We are

You_{MANY} are

They are

VERB: To be (Past tense)

I was

You_{ONE} were

He/she/it was

We were

You_{MANY} were

They were

VERB: To be (Future tense)

I will be

You_{ONE} will be

He/she/it will be

We will be

You_{MANY} will be

They will be

Present, past and future tenses - VERB = To have

VERB: To have (Present tense)

I have

You_{ONE} have

He/she/it has

We have

You_{MANY} have

They have

VERB: To have (Past tense)

I had

You_{ONE} had

He/she/it had

We had

You_{MANY} had

They had

VERB: To have (Future tense)

I will have

You_{ONE} will have

He/she/it will have

We will have

You_{MANY} will have

They will have
