 What do you think Dinah is going to do in school? Can you find any clues in the text to help. Include your evidence in your answer. <u>Read the rest of Chapter 6.</u>

 Can you explain how Dinah knows so much about the Solar System? Give evidence from the text.
What do you think is going to happen next to Lloyd, Harvey and Dinah? Do you think they will all have the same punishment? Include evidence!

Read Chapter 7

<u>I can identify childrens' rights.</u>

Dinah, Lloyd and Harvey are punished by the prefects for throwing snowballs. Do you think their punishment is fair? Are their rights being respected? Look at the Rights of the child, which rights are the children being denied in this school? In a group of 3 identify these rights and explain how they are being denied. What could the children do to help them have these rights?

Chapter 8


