

Help For My World 3 Greek Screens

All screens were designed and the trusty A3000 about 10 years ago.
Some are ok others - well make your own mind up.

Ancient Greece

1. Sieve: find prime numbers up to 100.

Use small shapes to cover multiples already covered.

Use red square to cover all multiples of 2 except 2

Yellow to cover multiples of 3 except 3.

Green to cover multiples of 5 except 5.

Blue for multiples of 7 but not 7

Uncovered numbers are primes.

2. Acropolis: build up a picture.

3. Plato 1 /2: make nets of Platonic Solids: icosahedron, octahedron, tetrahedron, cube and dodecahedron.

4. Athene: build picture.

5. Crete: decorate Cretan palace

6. Maze: rather complex- explore right angles to the Minotaur.

7. Roots: use root words on a tree.

8. Time: make a time line- rather complex.

9. Trade: place imports and exports on a map : (left to right) copper, pottery, slaves, iron, wine, papyrus, wood, honey, grain, olives, carrots, ivory and silver

10. Masks: design actor's masks.

11. Building: build a temple.

12. Numbers: make Hindu and Greek numbers.

13. Gods: use reference book to make family tree.

14. Hoplite: build a soldier.

15. Sparta: sort statements about Athens and Sparta (made preQCA!)

16. Amphora : design an amphora

17. Evidence: have a dig for dress pins, pottery, arrowheads, etc.

18. Mosaics: build up tiling patterns.

19. Map: label map.
