You are a Centurion in the Roman army.

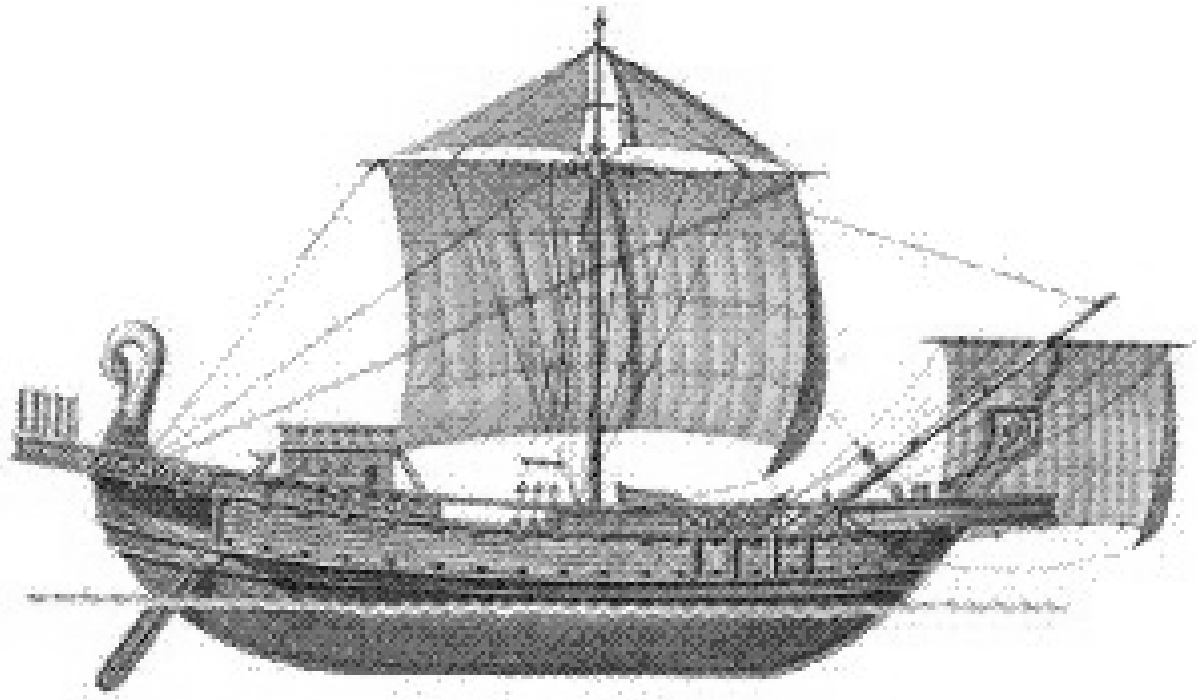
What is your Roman name?
