2. A cockroach has 6 legs.

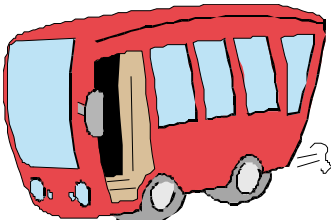
How many legs have 7 cockroaches?

How many more pages must I read to reach the middle?

6. You start to read a book on Thursday. On Friday you read 30 more pages than on Thursday. You reach page 110.

How many pages did you read on Thursday?

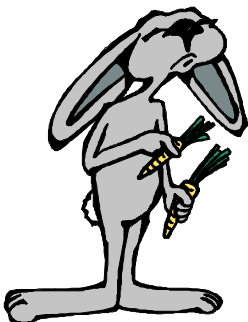
7. Which amounts up to £1 cannot be paid exactly with fewer than 6 coins?
