

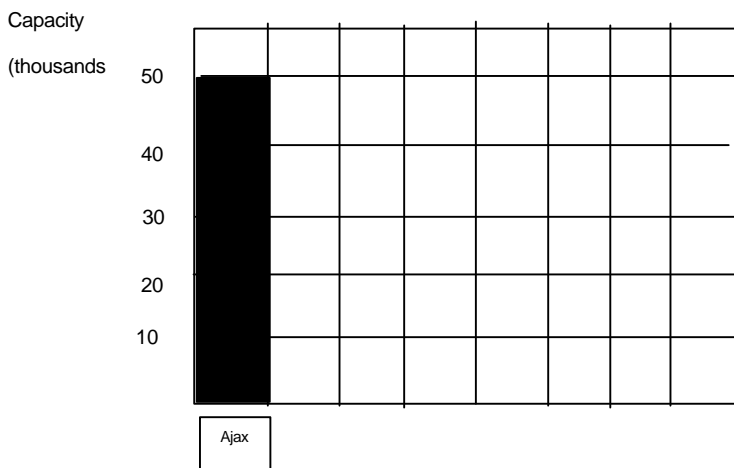
## Football Stadiums
