


School

"Our mum and dad help us with our homework and schoolwork too, but they don't tell us off. They don't look at our work until we give it to them" said Bob.




"They should look at your work more often if they want you to do well at school" one of the children said.

Fred thought about what the other children had said. Their dad was a good man, but he was at work every day. Their mum was at work until three o'clock, and came home the same time as them.




At the end of the day they all had food, then Bob and Fred went away to their own bedrooms.




There was not much on television, so Fred thought he would read his new book.
