

Multiplying by 20 by doubling

Write 1 or 2 digit numbers into the first box. Write it again in the first box in the second equation. 20 has been split into 2×10 . Use this idea to multiply by 20 in two stages, by 2 and then by 10. The first one has been done so that you can see what it looks like.

$$\boxed{12} \times \boxed{20} = \boxed{12} \times \boxed{2} \times \boxed{10} = \bigcirc 240$$

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
