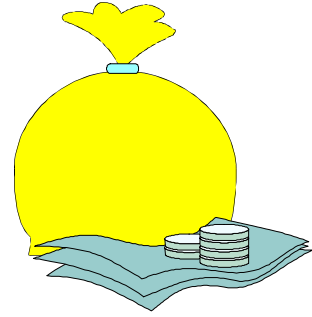


Decimals using money
