Jumping the Number Line

3. Freddo jumps from 8 to 84. How far is this big jump?
4. If Freddo starts at 39 and jumps all the way to 75, how far has he travelled?
5. What jump will Freddo make if he starts at 37 and ends up at 79?
6. Freddo had lots of energy and jumped from 25 to 81. How far did he jump?
7. If Freddo wants to get to see his friend at number 83, how far will he jump if he starts at 9?
8. How far will Freddo jump to get from 46 to 83?
